CGE MPUMALANGA PROVINCE TO HOST A CONSULTATIVE STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT WITH THE TRADITIONAL AND KHOISAN SECTOR

To: Editors and Reporters

The Commission for Gender Equality's (CGE) Mpumalanga Provincial Office will host a consultative stakeholder engagement with the traditional Khoi San sector on 02 July 2024. This engagement is informed by Section 2(1) of the Traditional and Khoi-San Leadership Act, 3 of 2019 that calls for a traditional community to transform and adapt customary law and customs relevant to the application of this Act to comply with the relevant principles contained in the Bill of Rights of the Constitution, in particular:

- a) Prevention of Unfair discrimination;
- b) Promotion of equality;
- c) Seeking to progressively advance gender representation in the succession to traditional and Khoi-San leadership positions.

It against this backdrop that the Commission is inviting members of the media to this consultative stakeholder engagement where the promotion of gender equality and women empowerment in the traditional sector will be discussed. The engagement will also discuss solutions to challenges faced by Makhosikati in the Province, and the status of Women's participation in Traditional Courts as per section 3(b) of the Traditional Courts Act 9 of 2022.
